This awareness adds a vivid dimension to the event filled and often mischievous activities described in the intimate diary of this rather naughty patrol leader's adventures around camp, into the New Forest, Lyndhurst (for sweets!) and to the Brockenhurst station. With familiarity of the surrounding one cannot simply read this diary, but be incredibly transformed to this wonderful place and the experiences within the stories. 
